Faculty of Management and Accounting

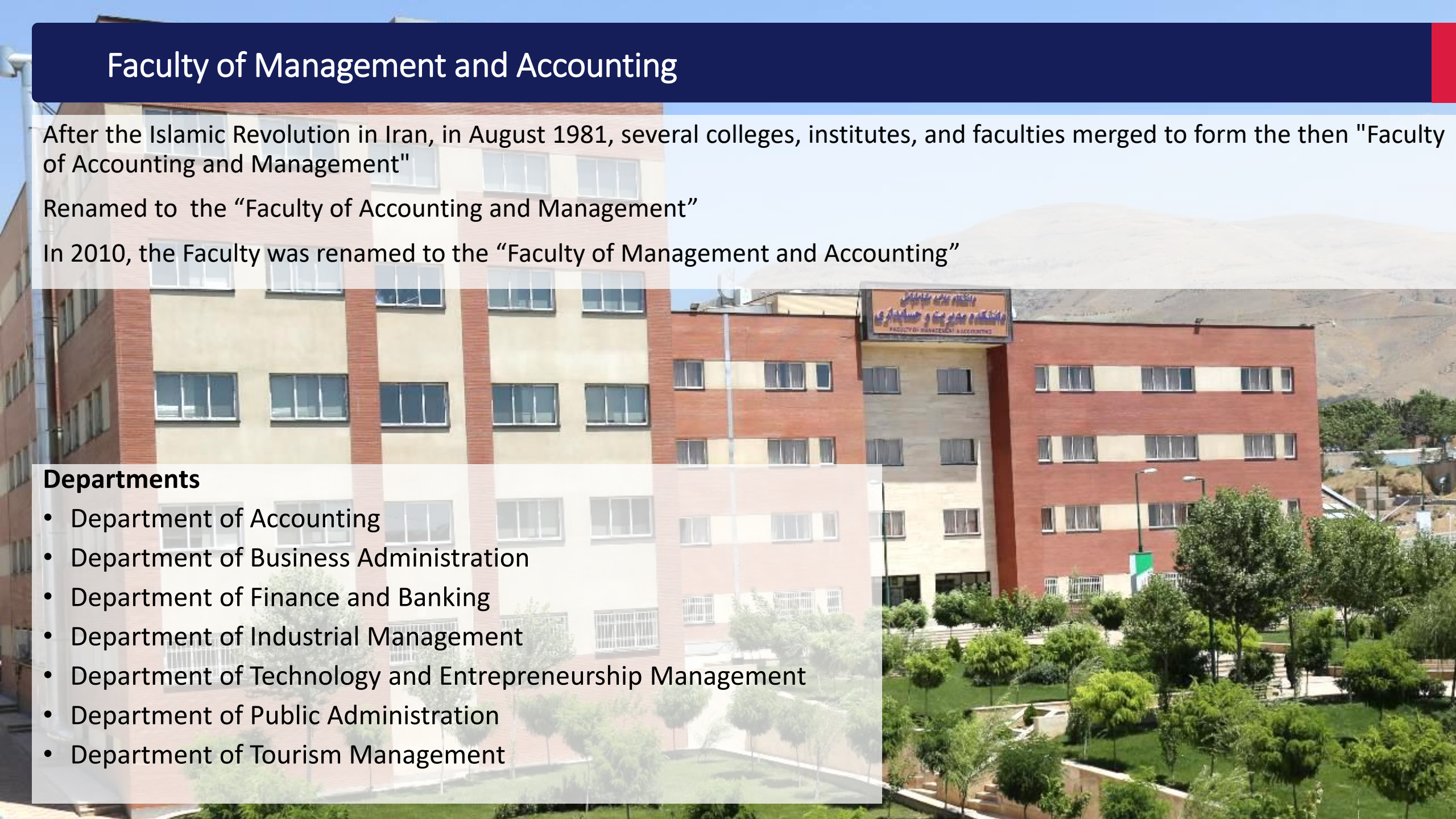
After the Islamic Revolution in Iran, in August 1981, several colleges, institutes, and faculties merged to form the then "Faculty of Accounting and Management"

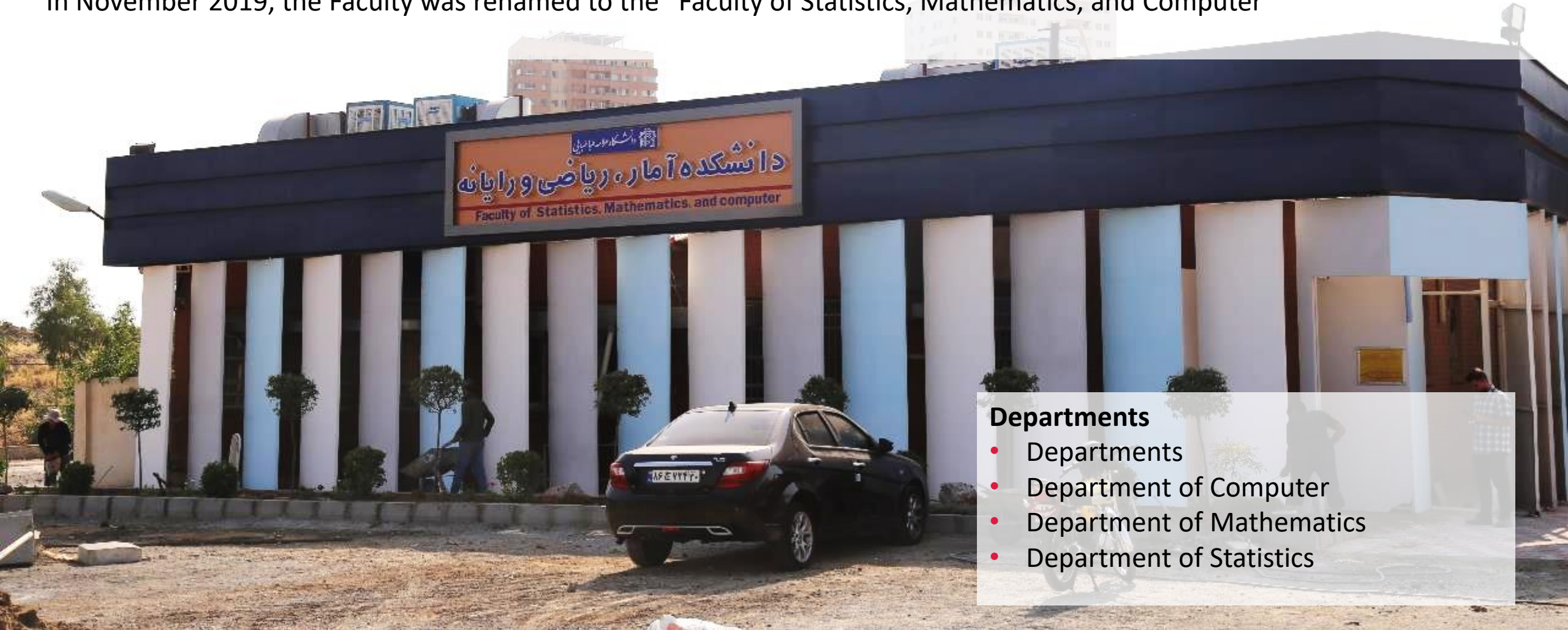
Faculty of Statistics, Mathematics, and Computer

In November 2019, the Faculty was renamed to the “Faculty of Statistics, Mathematics, and Computer”

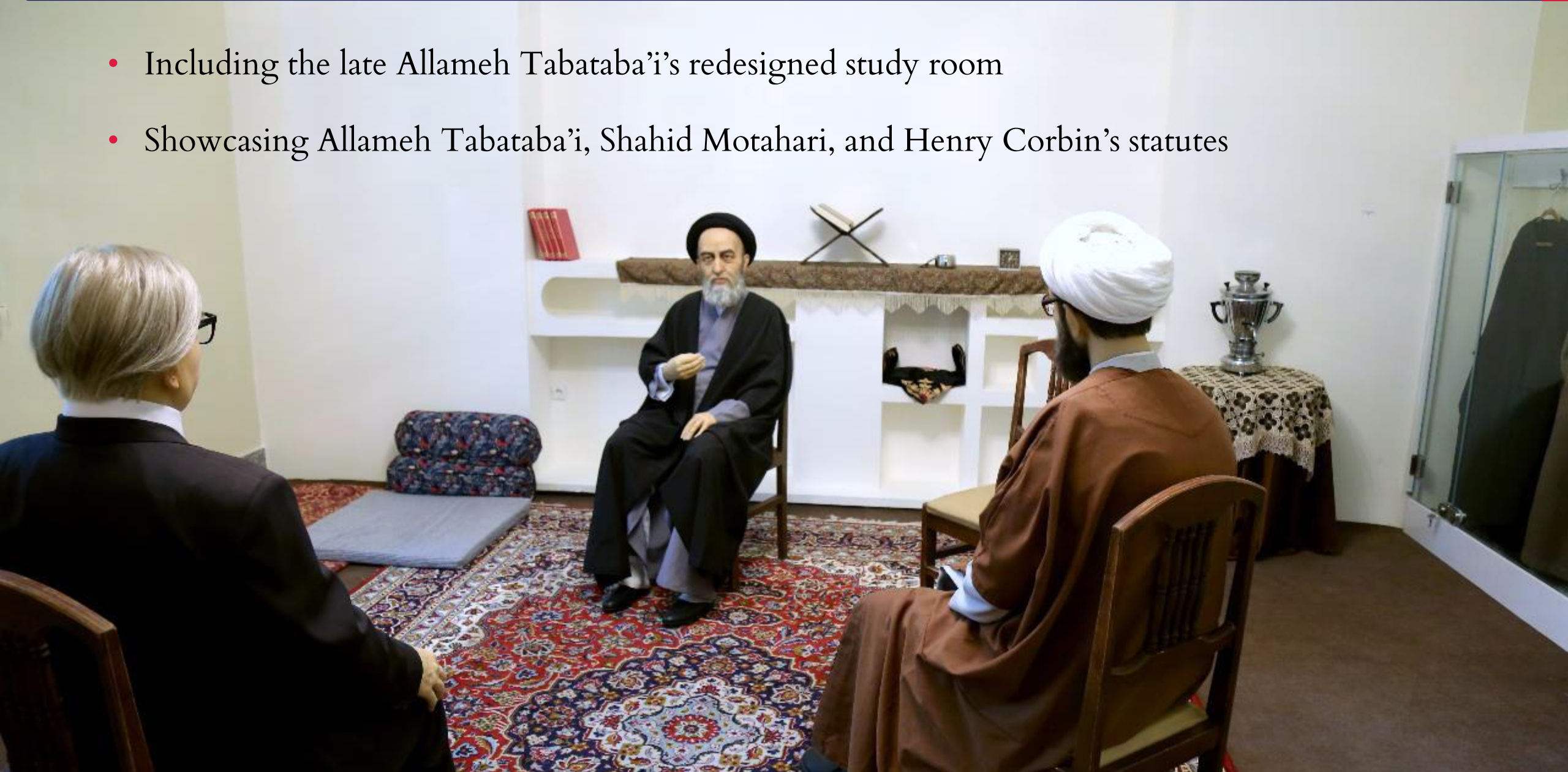
